STATIONS OF THE CROSS... provides a prayerful journey through the way of the cross, walking with our Lord from his trial to his burial.

BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT... offers us a chance to honor our Lord's continuing presence in the world, especially in the Blessed Sacrament, the Sacred Host.
